The Engaging Men Coordinator will implement EC male *promotores* program and EC domestic violence prevention classes.

Status: full time. Reports to the Director of Violence Prevention

Job description:

- Take leadership role in strategic planning, evaluation and implementation of Enlace Comunitario's Engaging Men's project;
- Coordinate Enlace Comunitario Male *Promotores* Leadership Project to ensure that *promotores* are educating Latino men about domestic violence and mobilizing them to work to end domestic violence.
- Recruit, train, supervise, and schedule *Promotores* for program and outreach activities.
- Provides group and one-on-one technical assistance and mentoring to the *promotores*.
- Secure strategic community presentation venues for EC male *promotores* to present to larger community;
- Co-facilitate violence prevention classes at Encuentro;
- Maintain documentation and produce reports of all prevention activities in EC database.
- Work with male *promotores* to develop media campaigns targeting Latino immigrant men;
- Work closely with other members of EC Prevention team to ensure collaboration across EC Prevention projects;
- Collaborate with community allies to promote Engaging Men programs;
- Outreach and recruit male participants for EC prevention classes;
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelors Degree preferred. One or more year related experience. Bilingual (English/Spanish). Valid NM Driver's License. Experience working with the Latino immigrant community and anti-violence movement.
