Serving indigenous female identifying, male identifying, and 2SLGBTQ+, individuals who may be experiencing social vulnerabilities (housing, transportation, food insecurity, medical instability, behavioral health) possibly capable of increasing risks associated with becoming missing/victims of violent crime.
